- Received 257 responses

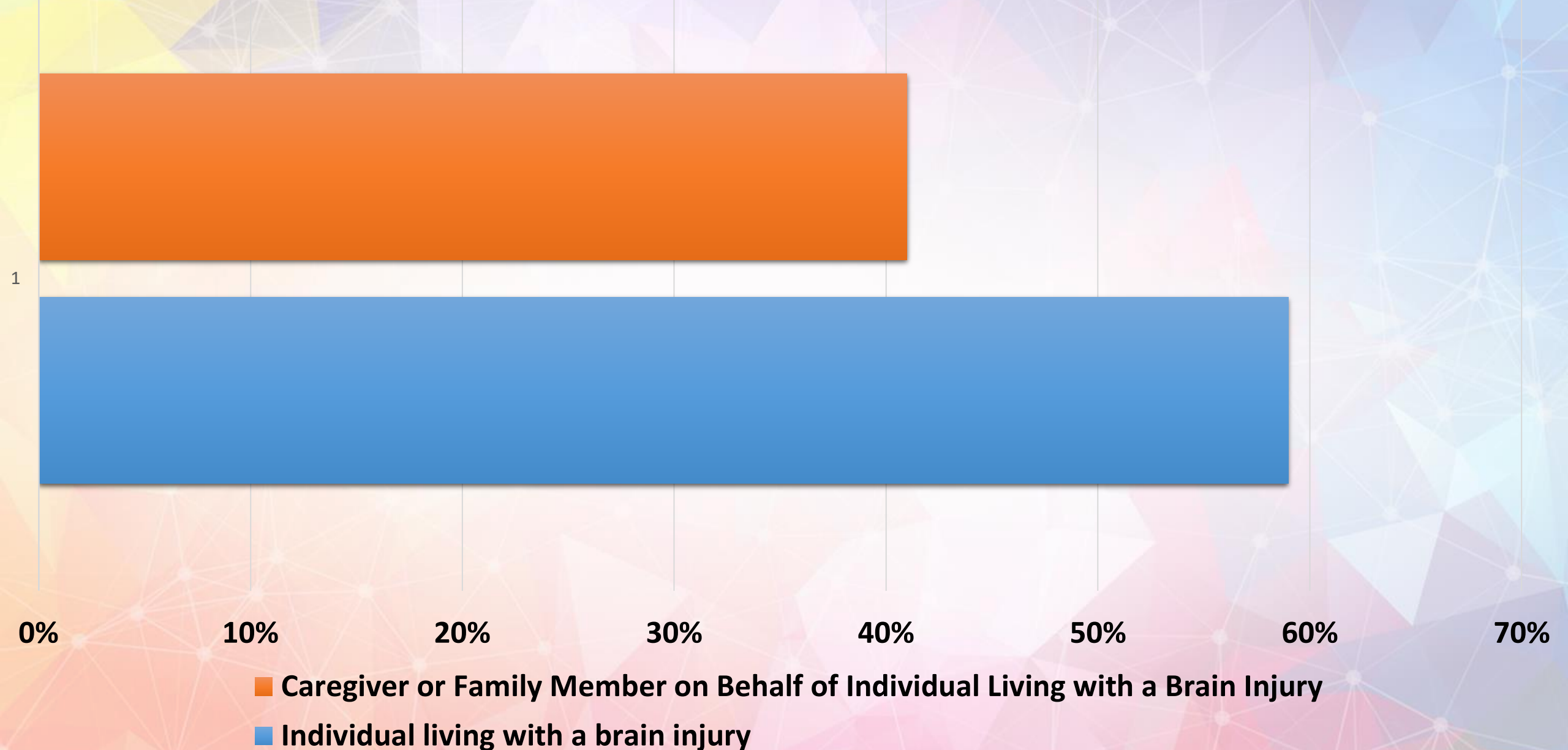
Needs & Gaps Survey

Average Age of Individual at Time of Incident: 35

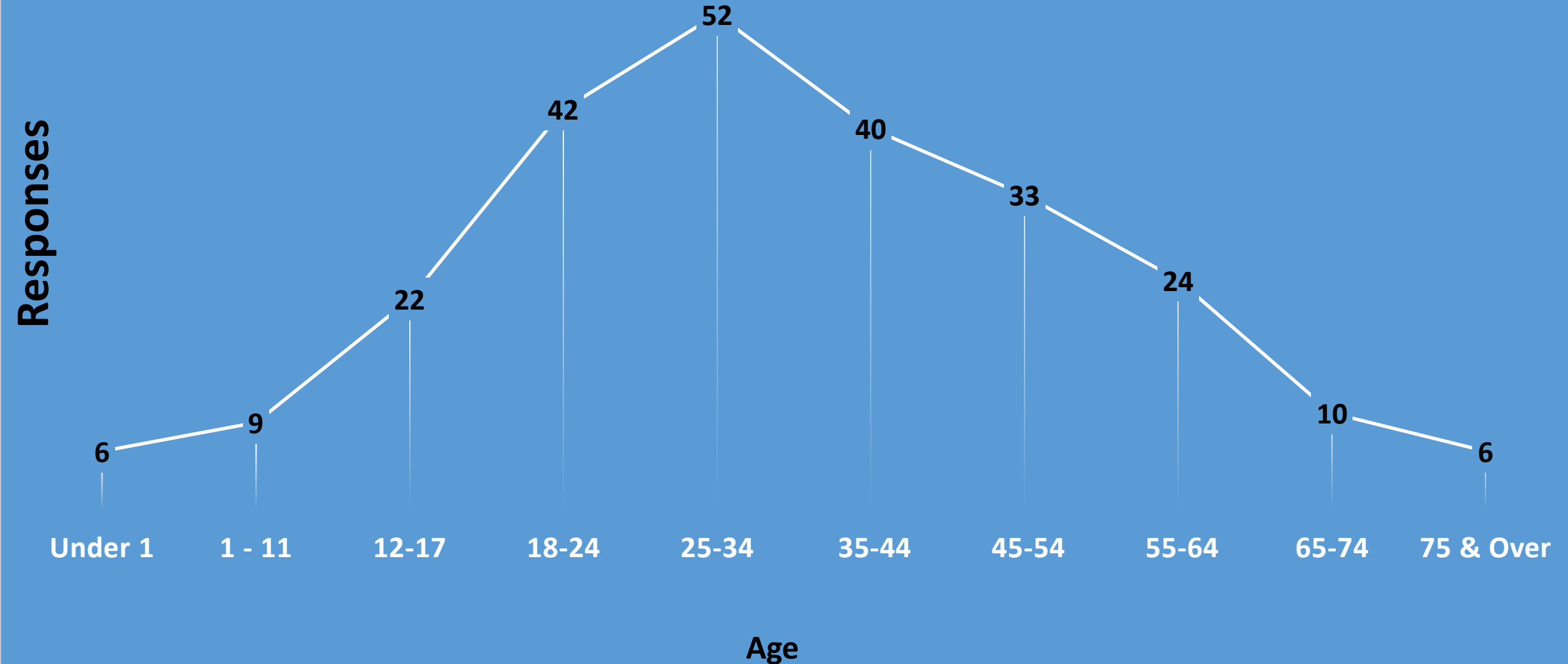
Average Years Individual has lived with Brain Injury: 13

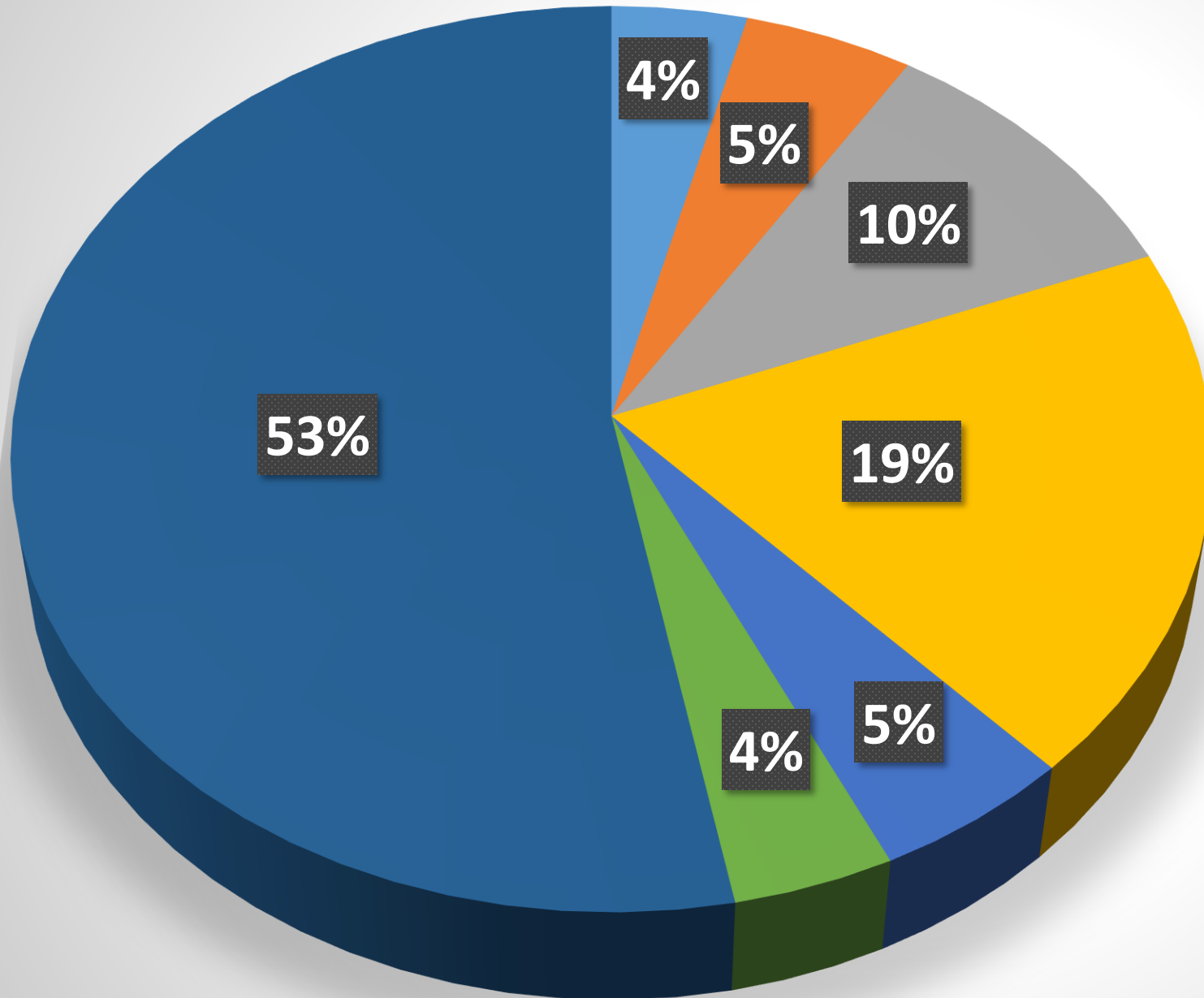

AGE OF INCIDENT

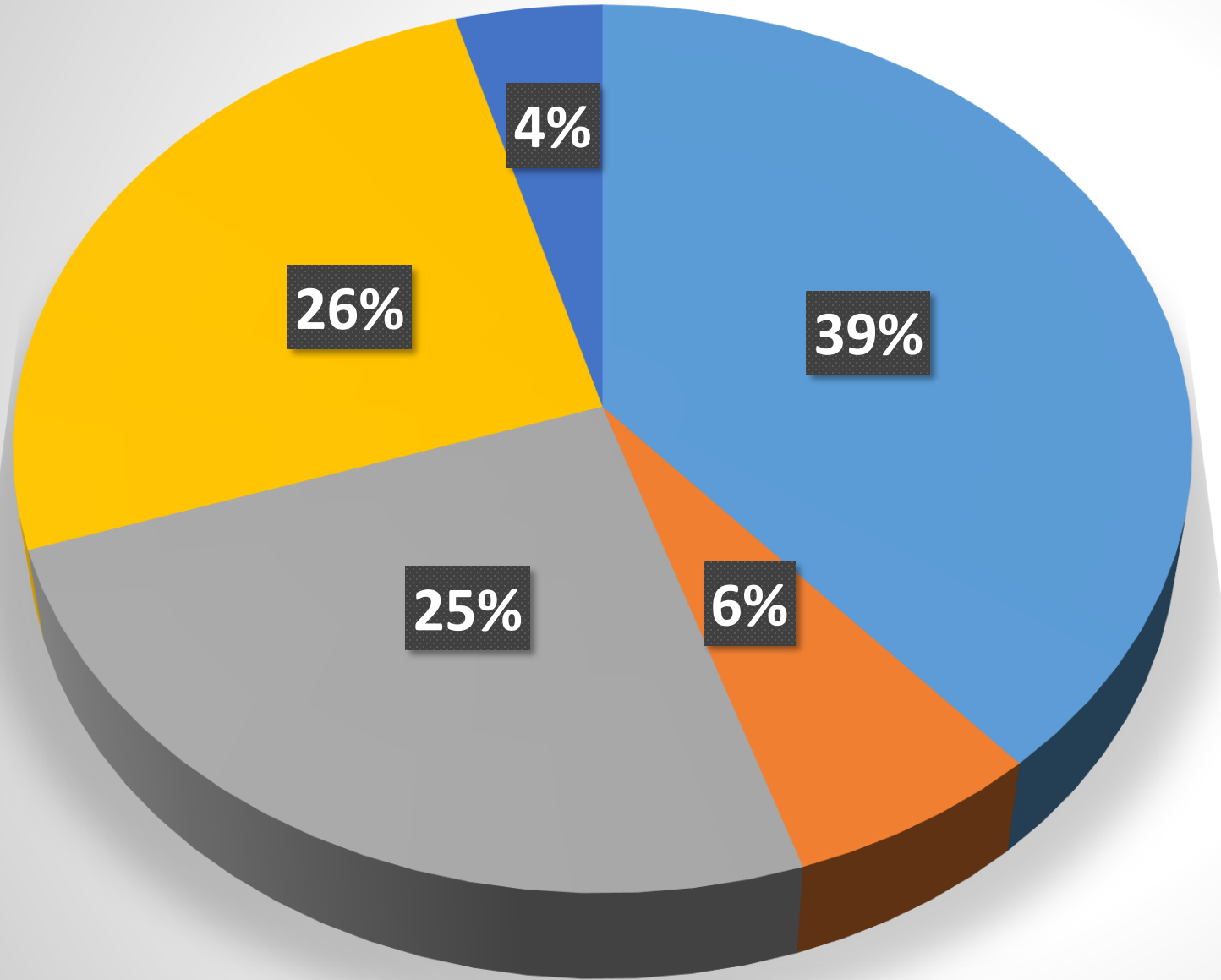

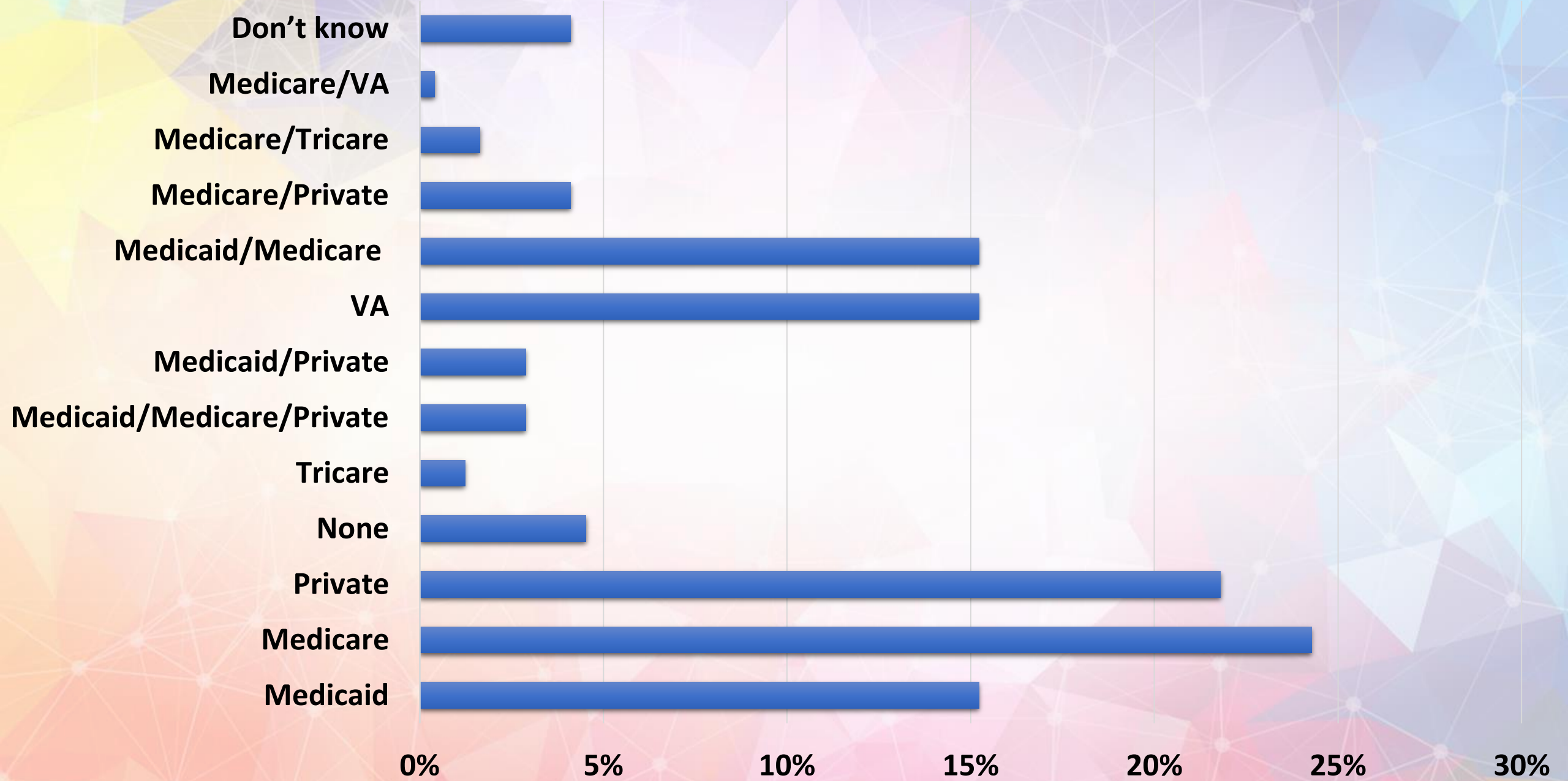

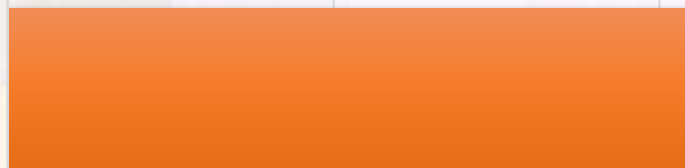

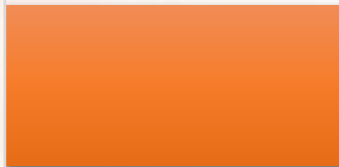


How satisfied were you (person with brain injury) with the guidance you received during discharge planning/before you left the provider's office about specific services and community resources related to brain injury?

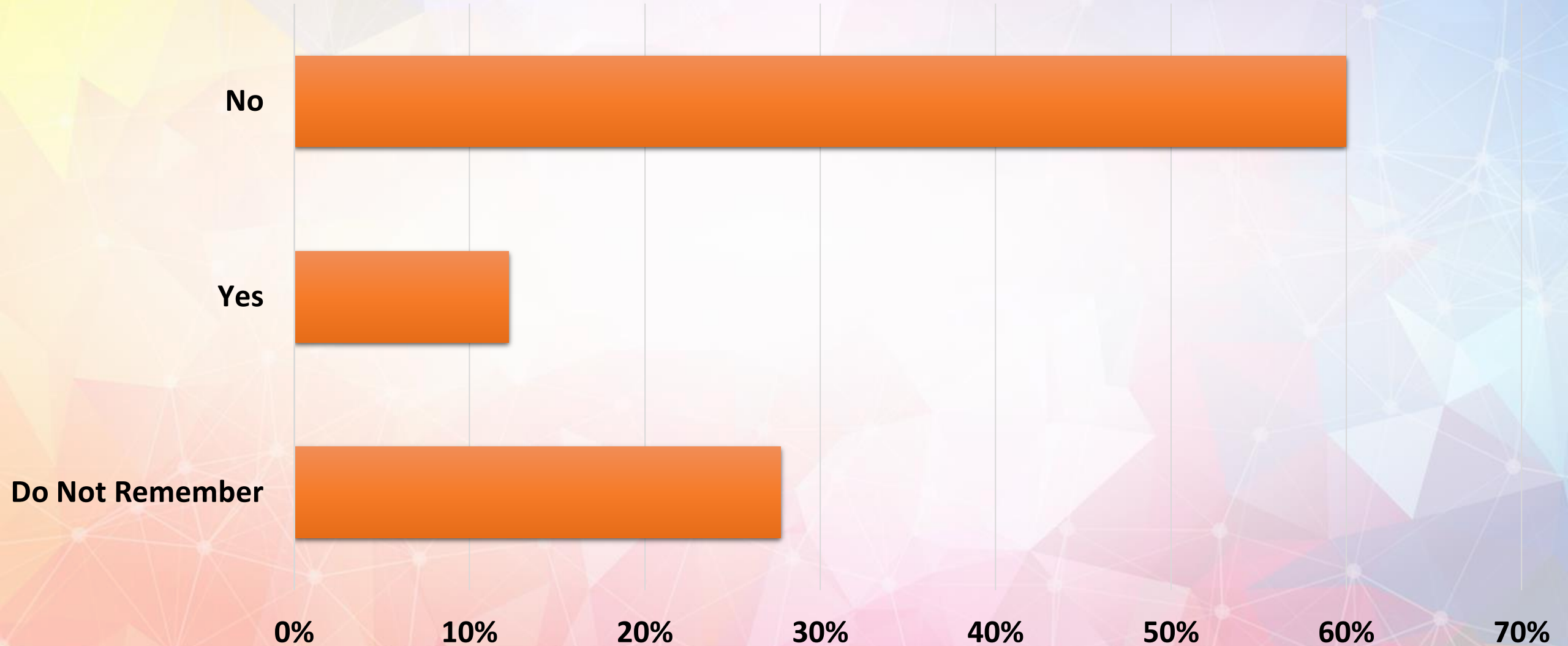

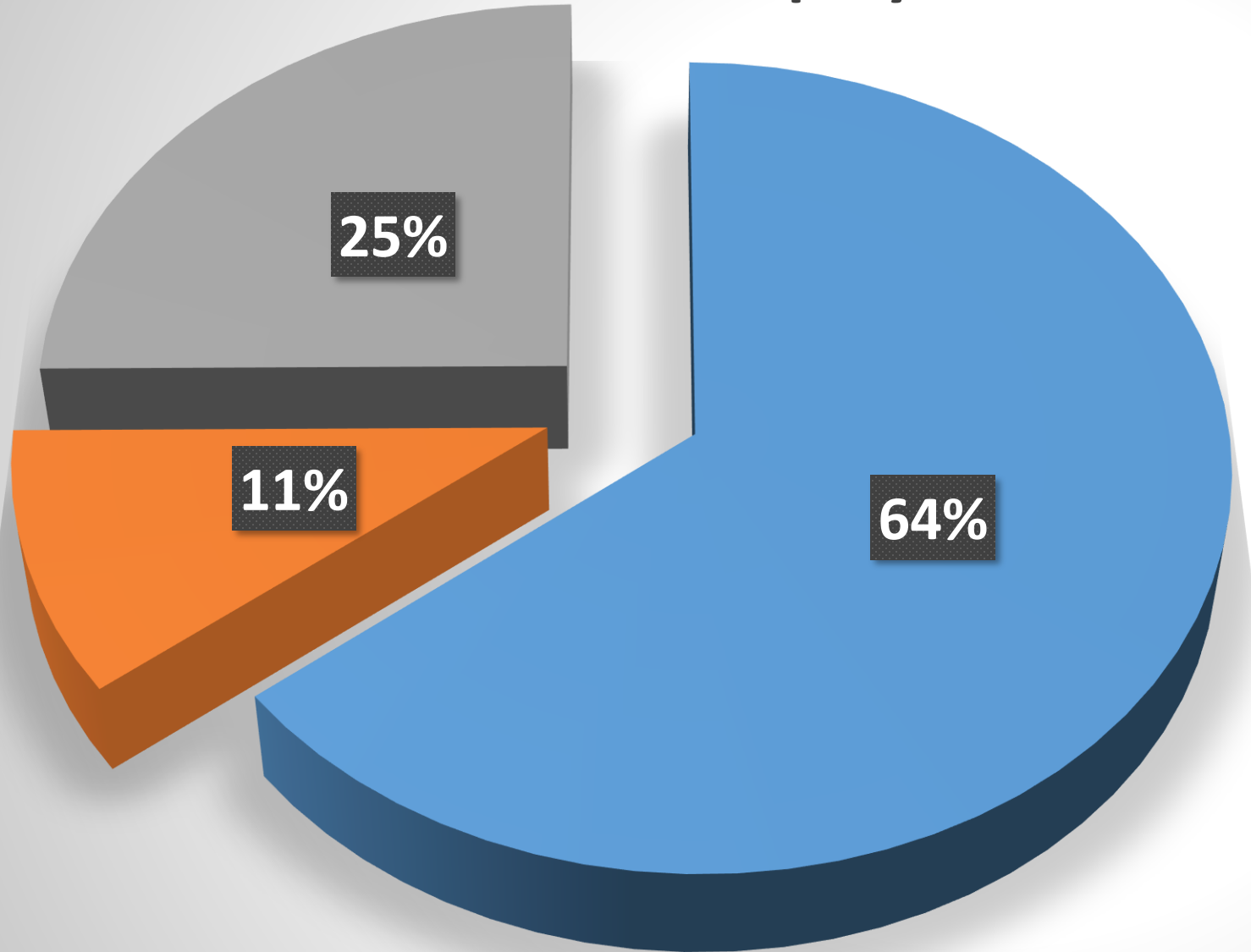
